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Hi all, i am trying to use a Display to change the look of ColumnList.

I have derived a class from ColumnList and Display like FileList does:

```
class NewList : public ColumnList, private Display {
public:
    NewList();
    virtual void Paint(Draw& w, const Rect& r, const Value& q, Color ink, Color paper, dword
style);
    Size GetStdSize();
}
```

and the implementation looks like this:

```
NewList::NewList() {
    SetDisplay(*this);
};
```

```
void NewList::Paint(Draw& w, const Rect& r, const Value& q, Color ink, Color paper, dword style)
{
    w.DrawRect(r,SGray());
};
```

```
Size NewList::GetStdSize() {
    Size sz;
    sz.cx=300;
    sz.cy=40;
    return sz;
}
```

But the Paint method of NewList ist never called - only StdDisplay::Paint is called.

what did i do wrong?
