Thank you very much for what you have done. I always missed that U++ could not be installed from a package repository.

I am trying to install it in WSL with Ubuntu, but I have problems. I'm sorry but I'm a flatpak newbie.

Following the instructions here, I have done this:

```
sudo apt install flatpak
```

```
sudo apt install gnome-software-plugin-flatpak
```

```
flatpak remote-add --if-not-exists flathub https://dl.flathub.org/repo/flathub.flatpakrepo
```

I have restarted. Then I have followed the instructions here:

Running this:

```
flatpak install flathub org.ultimatepp.TheIDE
```

It prints: No remote refs found similar to 'flathub'

Running this:

```
flatpak run org.ultimatepp.TheIDE
```

It prints: app/org.ultimatepp.TheIDE/x86_64/master not installed
