Hi,

A simple and useful macro, if you ever need to zip and export a U++ package.

This works on Linux but can be easily extended to other platforms.

It relies on a regular command line with a defined HOME variable. (Output path can be easily modified on-the-fly by using an input dialog though...)

```
macro "Export active package as zip file..." {  
    ClearConsole();  
    name = ActivePackage();  
    cmdline = "cd " + PackageDir(name) + "/.. && zip $HOME/" + name + " --exclude=*.git*  
--exclude=*.svn* -r " + name;  
    if(!Execute("sh -c \"" + cmdline + "\""))  
        Echo("Done!");  
}
```
