Code below won't compile out of the box:

```
namespace test {  
    struct Test;  
}
```

```
namespace test {  
    struct Test : Moveable<Test> {  
  
        Vector<Test> children;  
    };  
}
```

Adding of

```
template <> inline constexpr bool is_upp_guest<test::Test> = true;
```

won't help.

You need to add

```
template <> inline constexpr bool is_trivially_relocatable<test::Test> = true;
```

All this stuff is inconvenient and unnatural.

And I have no idea how to make code below compile.

```
struct Test01;
```

```
struct Test01 {  
  
    struct Test02 : Moveable<Test02> {  
  
        Vector<Test02> children;  
    };  
};
```
