Hello nemsys,

Welcome to our community! This error happens because the assembly data wasn't initialized correctly. Since the Arch package is unofficial, try one of these recommended installation methods instead:

Install TheIDE via Flatpak and Flathub. Note: Flatpak runs applications in a sandbox, which may restrict some functionality. However, in general everything should work as expected since compilation is being executed on the host operating system. Install from the tarball. Download from our official page [https://www.ultimatepp.org/www\\$suppweb\\$download\\$en-us.html](https://www.ultimatepp.org/www$suppweb$download$en-us.html) or directly from SourceForge. Also, you can find on GitHub on release pages.

The tarball is the most convenient way to get a fully functional U++ installation on Linux without limitations. If you want to spend significant amount of time and not only try our framework this is the recommended way.
