Hello Reza,

as far as I know (never used it) you can do this with custom Build steps (Press F1 for Help and go to "TheIDE help"->"Configuring Packages and Assemblies"->"Custom Build Steps"

right click in the upper part and choose "Append Row", give it a name and tell it the extension (.asm, i guess).

In the next part enter the command you want to be run (have a look at the screenshot in the Help) at last tell TheIDE which files will be created by that build step.

I don't know wether you have to add something to your package configuration so TheIDE will use your output.
