Below is the command from VS IDE:

```
nasm -f win32 -DPREFIX -I $(InputDir)\ -o "$(IntDir)\$(InputName)".obj "$(InputPath)"
```

Translated to plain english below:

```
nasm -f win32 -DPREFIX -I c:\Work\MyProject\asm\ -o "Debug\myasmfile".obj  
"c:\Work\MyProject\asm\myasmfile.asm"
```
