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I'm using something like these two functions to open and close sqlite database file:

```
void OpenDB()
{
    Sqlite3Session &sql_session = Single<Sqlite3Session>();
#ifdef _DEBUG
    sql_session.LogErrors(true);
#endif
    if(!sql_session.Open(ConfigFile("data.db"))) {
        LOG("Can't create or open database file\n");
        return;
    }

    // This is global:
    SQL = sql_session;
}
```

```
void CloseDB()
{
    Single<Sqlite3Session>().Close();
}
```

And in code I query database this way:

```
Sql sql;
sql * Select(SqlAll()).From(SOME_TABLE);
while(sql.Fetch()){
    //Do something
    Value some_field = sql[SOME_FIELD];
}
```
