You can be right, but I prefer clear coding, not wizards. E.g., to setup an SQL-based array, this code (copied from SQLApp example) is much more simple for me than clicking a lot. book.SetTable(BOOK); book.AddKey(ID); book.AddColumn(AUTHOR, "Author"); book.AddColumn(TITLE, "Title"); book.SetOrderBy(TITLE, AUTHOR);

Or setting up Edit controls as record field editors: ctrls (BORROWED, borrowed) (RETURNED, returned) (PERSON, person)

Maybe it is my personal perversion, that I like separating database related code from GUI (.lay in U++), but I can write really clear and maintainable code this way only.
