Also, possible bug, on my colleague's machine, which don't have much of the X11 stuff, he dies in `XftCharExists()`, from `DrawTextXftp.cpp:86`.

```
XftFont *xftfont = XftFontOpen(Xdisplay, Xscreenno,
                               XFT_FAMILY, XftTypeString, (char *)face,
                               XFT_PIXEL_SIZE, XftTypeInteger, 20,
                               (void *)0);

int n = 0;
for(int c = 0; c < 128; c++)
    if(!XftCharExists(Xdisplay, xftfont, c + 256))
        n++;
```

So I added:

```
XftFont *xftfont = XftFontOpen(Xdisplay, Xscreenno,
                               XFT_FAMILY, XftTypeString, (char *)face,
                               XFT_PIXEL_SIZE, XftTypeInteger, 20,
                               (void *)0);

if (!xftfont) return 0;
int n = 0;
```

Which stops it from coring and gets further in.
