Subject: problems with popup/pulldown menus on Gentoo/kde linux

Hello all,

I am having problems with popup and pulldown menus on the IDE and all examples both with precompiled versions (upp-linux386-605) and compiling (upp-src-2007.1beta, upp-src-2007.1beta2, upp-0.701.1, and directly from the SVN tree with borrowed Makefiles from the linux version).

The basic problem is all popup and pulldown menus disappear as soon as I attempted to move into them from the direction of the original click, but will allow to enter them by first moving away and entering them from a different side than the closest. As an example, if I choose the AddressBook demo I can only get it to build by either using the F7 hot-key or by clicking on build, moving up and away from the pulldown list (without moving the mouse over Debug, Assist, or Setup), and then move into the list from the side or below. Similar behavior occurs with popups. My guess is that there is a logical flip somewhere in the menu code.

Anyone have ideas what's going on before I start wading through the code with a debugger?

BTW, I am running Gentoo-Linux(2.6.18-r6), gcc(4.1.1), xorg-x11(7.1), kde(3.5.5)
