I created a MT application with u++, and run it without mingw10.dll successfully. This is not supposed to be possible. Multithreaded applications should be built with the "-mthreads" option given to the compiler, which will trigger dynamic linking to mingw10.dll. It is promised that a future version of MinGW will remove this severe inconvenience. There are long discussions about this topic on the Qt forum.
