You can try running the following command from a terminal window:

```
pkg-config --cflags gtk+-2.0
```

If that return a "no package found error" then you need to install gtk+-2.0+. On the other hand, if it gives you something reasonable then add the next few lines to the makefile:

```
CINC = -I$(UPPDIR1) \  
      $(shell pkg-config --cflags libpng gtk+-2.0 xft x11)  
LIBS = $(shell pkg-config --libs libpng gtk+-2.0 xft x11)
```

Then you will need to remove the hard coded linked libs from the final link stage (just look for -lX11, and similar). Replace all of these with \${LIBS}. That hopefully will do it. Oh, remember to remove the -DflagNOGTK...
