thanks for the interesting comments. I'd be interested in reading up on these gcc-3.3 issues, since 3.3 is the last release-series to support certain deprecated compiler-behaviour.

in the meantime I'll upgrade to 4.1.2 -- I just wish there where some list of all open-source c++-libs so that I could find each potential incompatibility beforehand...

as for the -Os, I know that it's size-optimization, and strangely -O2 -finline-limit didn't work (is the latter parameter ignored for -O2?).

so, dear ebojd, please give me some links or google-words to find anything about problems with gcc-3.3, bugzilla isn't very helpful when searching for particular bugs. as a side-note, I did experience various problems with optimization in gcc-3.3, but that was always with some machine-dependant optimizations. so, maybe the actual bug is within upp (probably some expected behaviour was really undefined behaviour according to the gcc-developers or something).
