At least, the list of classes with their hierarchy? And/Or some more explanations about what you try to do with databases in UPP? I was thinking, as unodgs, that your goal was to have a database-independant interface. But I agree with Mirek that it seems difficult because of the many differences between RDBMS... So, I don't understand very well yet what must do the interface?

In others words, I don't understand yet how to get started to do that ! Some more advices, if possible, will be welcome !
