I can confirm this bug.  
Apparently you are the first Linux user to try the Paint example

What happens is, that DrawEllipse() defaults to Null for the pen size. Null = INT\_MIN = -2<sup>31</sup>. This Value then gets passed to void Draw::SetLineStyle(int width), which can not handle it.

Some if(IsNull()) statement missing in SetLineStyle)?  
Does upp not use the default pen on Windows in this case, or how has that gone amiss?
