This is what I tried right now. Unfortunately, it doesn't work (i. e. the tab is empty even if I fill the ArrayCtrl with data), or did I miss something?

I created a simple project, with a top window, a tab control, and a button. When button is clicked, the following code is fired:

ArrayCtrl array;

if (tab.GetCount() == 0)
tab.Add(array.SizePos(), "test");
else
{
tab.Add(array.SizePos(), "test");
tab.Set(tab.GetCount() - 1);
}
array.AddColumn("test1");
array.AddColumn("test2");
array.Add("test1", "test2");

When the second tab is created, and you try to switch to the first tab, an exception is thrown, like, EXCEPTION\_ACCESS\_VIOLATION.

When a grid control is used, there are no errors but still no result.
