```
datagrid.Add(String(sql[1]), IntStr(sql[2]), IntStr(sql[3]), String(sql[4]), String(sql[5]), String(sql[6]));
```

BTW, I suppose datagrid is an ArrayCtrl variable. There is no need to convert sql values to string type as arrayctrl can store different type values and display them properly. This line of code should rather look like:

```
datagrid.Add(sql[1], sql[2], sql[3], sql[4], sql[5], sql[6]);
```

or like in your case if you store sql values in array ctrl one by one this row can be written simply as:

```
datagrid.Add(sql);
```
