Novo wrote on Wed, 23 May 2007 15:51: The easiest ways to fix your problem is to call `CtrlSetDefaultSkin(ChStdSkin, ChHostSkin)` from one of the possible places listed below.

- 1) `GUI_APP_MAIN`;
- 2) A constructor of a class inherited from `TopWindow`;
- 3) A constructor of a `"your_class : public your_layout<TopWindow>"`;

I think Mirek could put this call somewhere inside of `TopWindow`. That would solve all these problems with `.icpp` files.

I hope that helps.

That would solve the problem with `CtrlLib.icpp`. But there is a lot of other `.icpp` files.

Obviously, alternative approach would be to provide some "register" function for each `.icpp` file, which could be empty and call in in `MAIN`. But we want to be as "automatic" as possible...
