This is related to the pkg-config issues discussed previously. You can take the output from that and freetype-config and put them in the CINC and LIBS variables of the Makefile during upp compilation. Here is an old example from portage:

```
if use truetype ; then
  CINC="${CINC} `freetype-config --cflags`"
  LIBS="${LIBS} `freetype-config --libs`"
fi

if use gtk2 ; then
  CINC="${CINC} `pkg-config gtk+-2.0 --cflags`"
  LIBS="${LIBS} `pkg-config gtk+-2.0 --libs`"
else
  CINC= "-DNOGTK" # not sure this is correct
fi
```

This will then properly align the stars...

Hope that helps.
