- 1) Backup your .../uppsrc/CtrlLib/Ctrl.Impl
- 2) Download Ctrl.Impl.zip, extract, and overwrite .../uppsrc/CtrlLib/Ctrl.Impl
- 3) Compile any example, or Thelde itself to see the "more native" Win2000 look.
Even if you break something, which is quite unprobable, it's very easy to reinstall u++.
