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Hi Guys,

I just started working on a console app and when launching TheIDE, the package/project does not list? It's listed in the MyApps folder. Here's a simple example of the steps taken:

- 1) Launch TheIDE
- 2) Select New Package
- 3) From the Create new package dialog box, select, "Core console project"
- 4) For package name, type, "Hello"
- 5) Select the Create button
- 6) Edit one's program as such:

```
#include <Core/Core.h>
#include <iostream>
```

```
using namespace Upp;
using namespace std;
```

```
CONSOLE_APP_MAIN
{
    cout << "HELLO" << endl;
}
```

- 7) Save the program
- 8) Launch and test the program
- 9) Exit and restart TheIDE
- 10) Hey, where did the project go???
