Hello,

If you want to have access to U++ SVN please read following site -
[https://www.ultimatepp.org/www\\$suppweb\\$svnInstall\\$en-us.html](https://www.ultimatepp.org/www$suppweb$svnInstall$en-us.html).

Alternatively, you could use git mirror from Github. I believe this is better solution if you don't want to commit anything to U++. To clone repository, just execute following command in your terminal:

```
git clone https://github.com/ultimatepp/mirror.git
```

The git mirror is synchronized with SVN, so it is absolutely up to date. The delay between commit to SVN and GIT mirror takes around one minute or even less.
