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Hello all

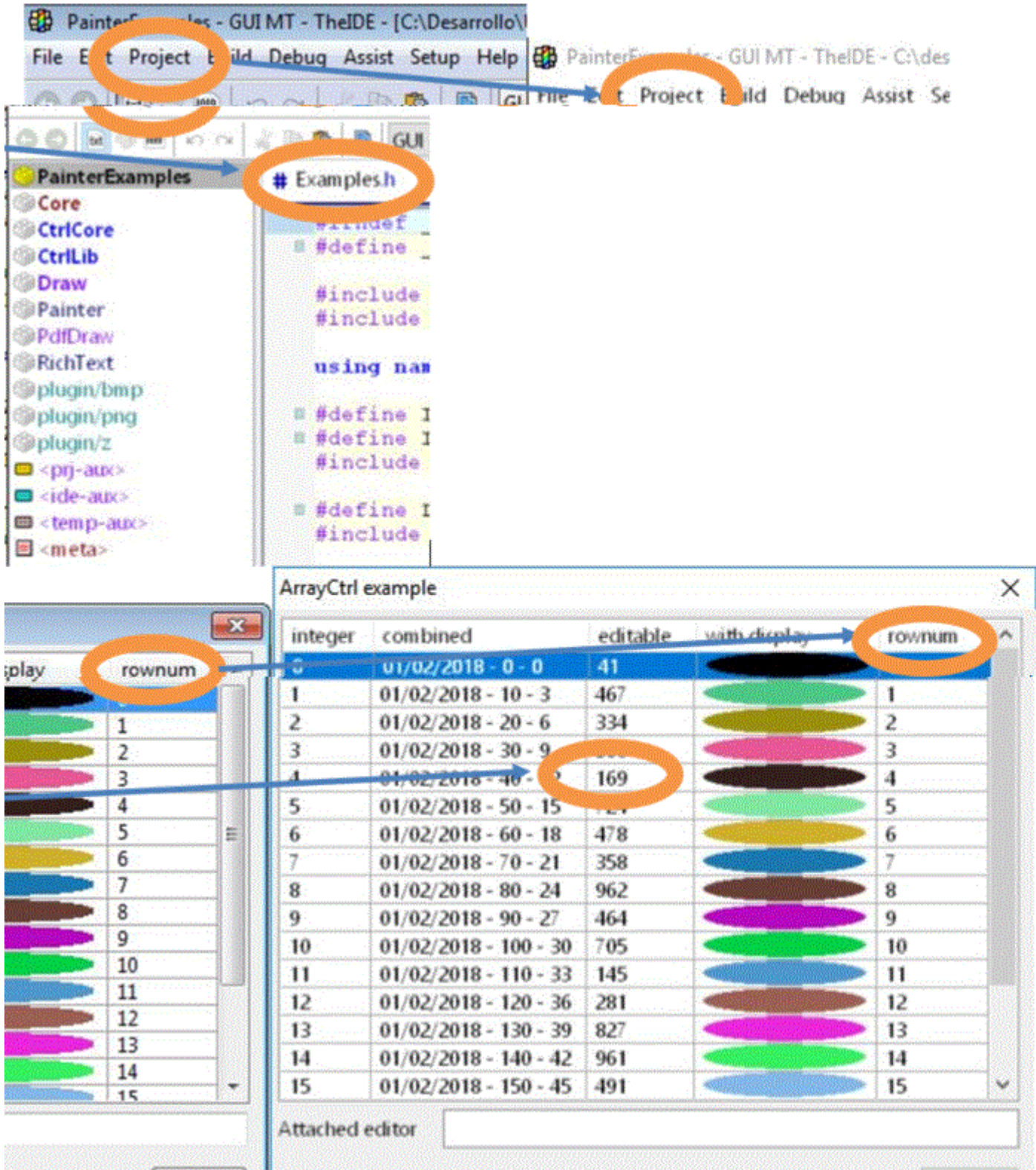
I think that the U++ applications seem blurred in Windows 10.

We need more information like your desktop resolution, dpi etc. It is important, because when we detect that there is 4K or 8K resolution we run in another GUI mode that scale the interface, so it might be the problem.

However, I used U++ with Windows 10 with FullHD resolution and I didn't find any issue related to blurry. The other clue is the font used by us.
