Hello,

on an old laptop I have a MSC9 compiler installed in 2014.
I tried to compile the latest U++ but it fails:

```
C:\upp\uppsrc\Core/Core.h (45): fatal error C1189: #error : This version of U++ REQUIRES C++11
```

I tried to add the compiler option

```
/std:c++11
```

and still complain:

```
cl : Command line warning D9002 : ignoring unknown option '/std:c++11'
```

Can that version compile the new U++ or I must get rid it?

You must update your compiler. MSC9 is too old to work with the latest version of the U++, it is even to old for the previous release. Just grab Visual Studio 2017 community edition and enjoy latest version of U++ :)
