Welcome on our forum! Can you attach the full screen of TheIDE not only the compilation output. I think your error might be related to lack of toolchain. Are you sure you downloaded upp-mingw-x instead of upp-win. Also, please let me know that you can compile exemplary packages such as "example/Clock".

BTW, three weeks ago I just bought the same CPU and it works like a charm with U++ :) However, I am using it on Linux and TheIDE compiles in less than two minutes (Release mode).
