The last line of code above, causes the application to CRASH!

That is to be expected :) Get/SetData() works with Value, which can hold several datatypes but it doesn't perform any implicit conversions. To get the value from editDouble as string, you need to use ToString() or operator~(): docEdit.SetData(editDouble.GetData().ToString());

// or

docEdit.SetData(~editDouble.GetData());
