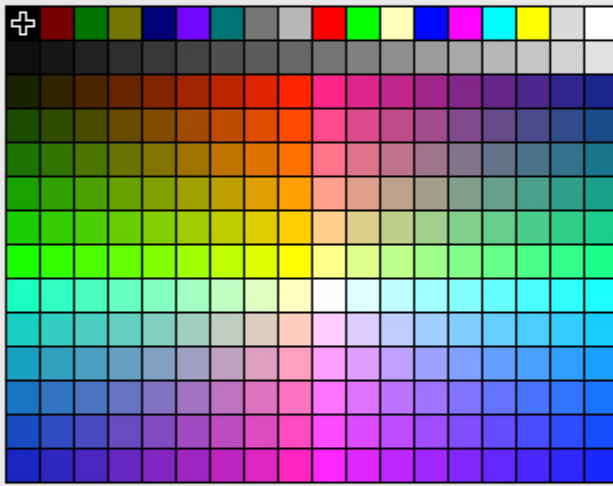
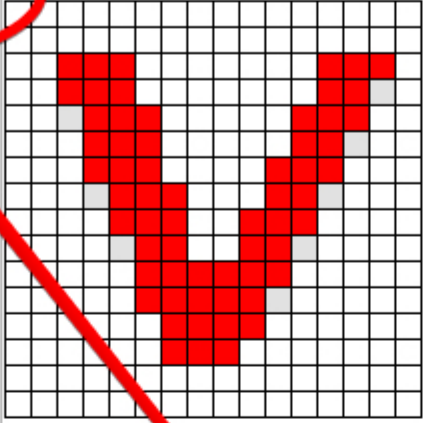
I was not lucky or I missed something. See the picture attached.
