Hello Varu,

It seems that you have old GDK library installed on your system. From the library reference GDK_AXIS_ROTATION is available from version 3.22. Could you update Lubuntu to version 20.4 and see if it works there. 16.4 seems very old. Alternatively, you could try some older upp releases that are appropriate for your operating system from SourceForge.
