When I compile and link the release "upp-posix-16828" i got the message:

Background:

The reason for update to newer version was, that I got a linker error

by linking my program (in the past, this program was compiled and linked without errors).

The error was about 'SSL_get1_peer_certificate'.

So the idea was that maybe this is fixed with a newer release of ultimate++.

I don't know the meaning of SSL-Certificate. Is there a certificate missing or is it a library issue with a SSL-Library or what is the problem?

Maybe you can help me to fix it.
