    name = ActivePackage();
    cmdline = "cd" + PackageDir(name) + "/.. && zip $HOME/" + name + " --exclude=*.git*
--exclude=*.svn* -r" + name;
    if(!Execute("sh -c \"" + cmdline + "\""))
        Echo("Done!");
}
```
