GraphCtrl examples do not compile due to fatal error GrapCtrl
"/home/klugier/upp/git/uppsrc/Draw/iml_header.h (17): fatal error:
'GraphCtrl_Demo/GraphCtrl_Demo.iml' file not found" Also when opening GraphCtrl,
TimingPolicies package is missing. Did you forget to create UppHub package for it? Or it is no
longer needed? GraphCtrl package shouldn't be main package since it is supportive package. You should remove "GUI SSE2" configuration
