The macro below runs the LazyGit application on the terminal for the active package. This is to simplify git management. Currently, TheIDE's git integration is very limited. To compensate this, you can use the below macro on any POSIX system. (I am using Bobcat with a predefined LazyGit profile here, but you can modify it easily to suit your needs. For example you can set different LazyGit operations per macro, etc.).

```
macro "Run LazyGit" Ctrl+Shift+Space {  
  Launch("/usr/bin/bobcat -p LazyGit -d \"\" + PackageDir(ActivePackage()) + "\"");  
}
```
