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Hello!

Just to be sure, I'm starting a separate thread so it doesn't get overlooked ;)
I'd like to report an issue with the HTTPS example from the reference:

1. First issue – the attached certificates have been invalid for some time now.
2. Even after connecting new valid certificates (self-signed), when I enter https://localhost:4000 into the browser, an error message appears in the browser window:

The localhost server is using an unsupported protocol.
ERR_SSL_VERSION_OR_CIPHER_MISMATCH

And in the application logs:

```

Maybe the server.crt expiry date expired.

You need to create a new server.crt and server.key file according to the following method.

```
//1. Gen CA file. myca.key, myca.cert
openssl genrsa -aes256 -out myca.key 2048
openssl rsa -in myca.key -out myca.key
openssl req -new -x509 -days 3650 -key myca.key -out myca.crt -subj
"/C=CN/ST=SD/L=YT/O=xx/OU=CA/CN=MYCA/emailAddress=youremail@xxx.com"
```

```
//2. gen server.key and server.crt
openssl genrsa -aes256 -out server.key 2048
openssl rsa in server.key -out server.key
```

```
openssl req -new -key server.key -out server.csr -subj
"/C=CN/ST=SD/L=YT/O=xxx/OU=RD/CN=xxx/emailAddress=youremail@xxx.com"
```

```
openssl x509 -req -days 3650 -in server.csr -CA myca.crt -CAkey myca.key -CAcreateserial -out

```
