These are from RichEdit.lay

allow orphans - "orphan" is single line of paragraph left on another page. Normally, RichText does not allow that to happen (it does not look well).

keep together - whole paragraph must be placed on single page

keep with next - next paragraph must start on the same page as this paragraph ends.
