I'm using Upp 605 on a RedHat Enterprise Linux 4 to create an application which has to run on the second monitor.

When I execute the program on the first monitor, there isn't any problem but when I execute it (or examples from upp) on the second monitor, the main appears on the first (very degraded) and this error is displayed a lot on the console of the second screen :
