Subject: HeaderCtrl can now move (reorganize) tabs

You can now drag&drop HeaderCtrl tabs, activated by Moving modifier.

In order to achieve different order (e.g. in ArrayCtrl columns), tabs now remember their "original" index.

You can retrieve this index by

```
int HeaderCtrl::GetTabIndex(int i)
```

or find a column with index using

```
int HeaderCtrl::FindIndex(int i)
```

ArrayCtrl's HeaderCtrl has this feature activated by default; can be disabled by NoMovingHeader.

Also, HeaderCtrl tabs now have "WhenBar" action to invoke the context menu with right-click on the Tab.
