BTW, the 'secret' IP now is less secret... just use svn !

Enter on a folder of your coice (usually ~/ or better ~/sources/) and do

```
svn co https://upp.svn.sourceforge.net/svnroot/ uppdev
```

And you'll get your 'uppdev' folder with sources, examples, tutorial and bazaar files.
