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I have some packages from which I need to make shared libs (both dll and .so). Packages use each other to some extent.

For example :

Packages A, B, C, D

B & C uses A

D uses B & C

I'd need A.dll, B.dll, C.dll and D.dll (or .so), without code duplication in them, do B.dll & C.dll refers to A.dll and D.dll refers to B.dll and C.dll.

How should I do it ?

EDIT : that should be done in a *simple* way, i.e. without having to build A.dll first, then adding it as a lib to B & C, then building B & C and then adding A, B & C dlls as libs on D.dll... that would be too time consuming in my case.
