- 1. I have a simple class implemented in a *. and a *.cpp. If I chose "Navigate in the file..", it works fine in the *.h, but it displays gibberish and cant execute a jump if I use it in *.cpp file.
- 2. If I extract the enum declaration from the class, Assist++ does not display the enum values in the autocomplete list.
- 3. Would it be possible in the dialog from "Navigate in the file.." to group somehow together the items from enum?
- 4. I just noticed that TheIDE uses ".." at the end of a menu name which opens a dialog. Any good reason why "..." is not used? It is standard, but not too important .
