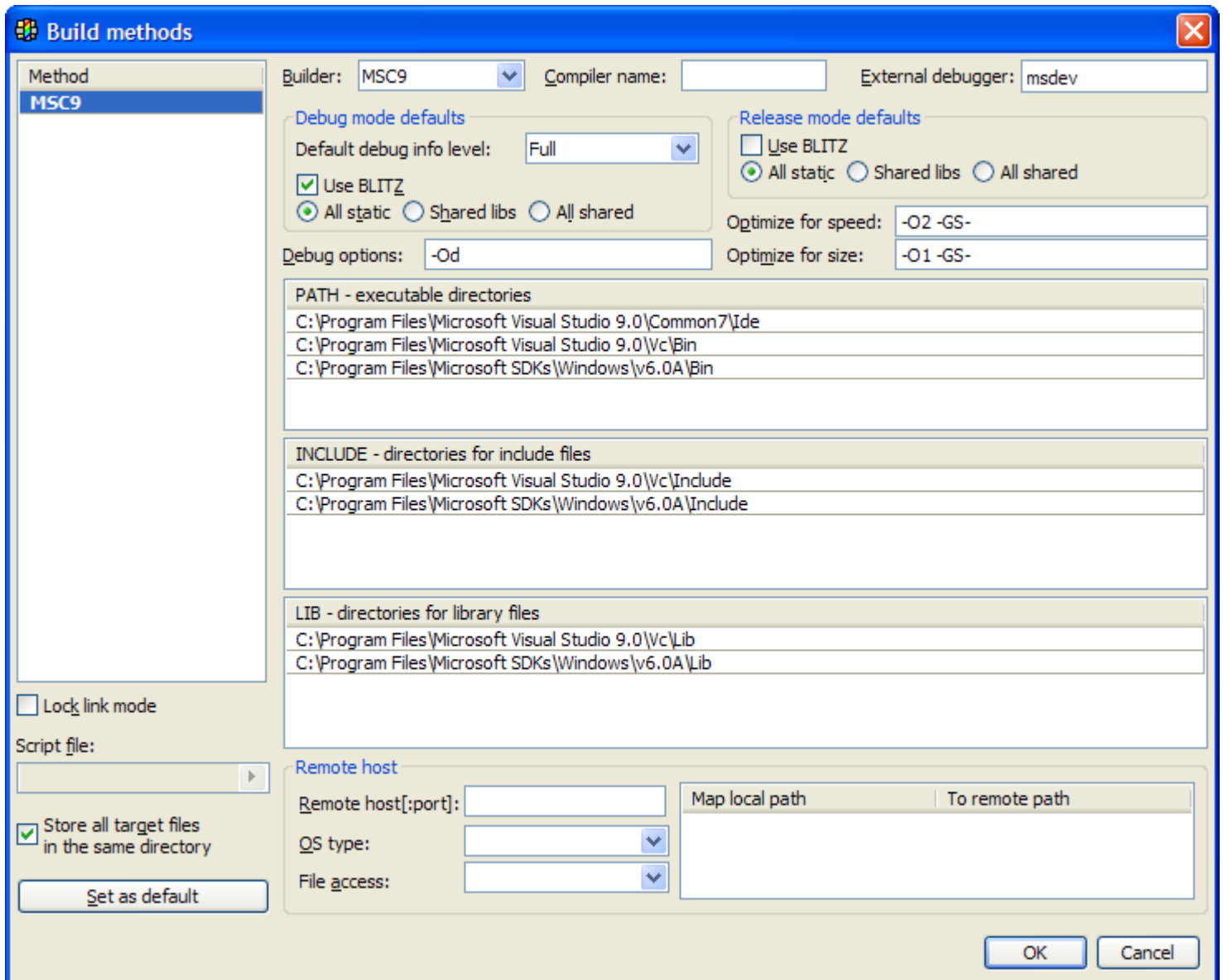

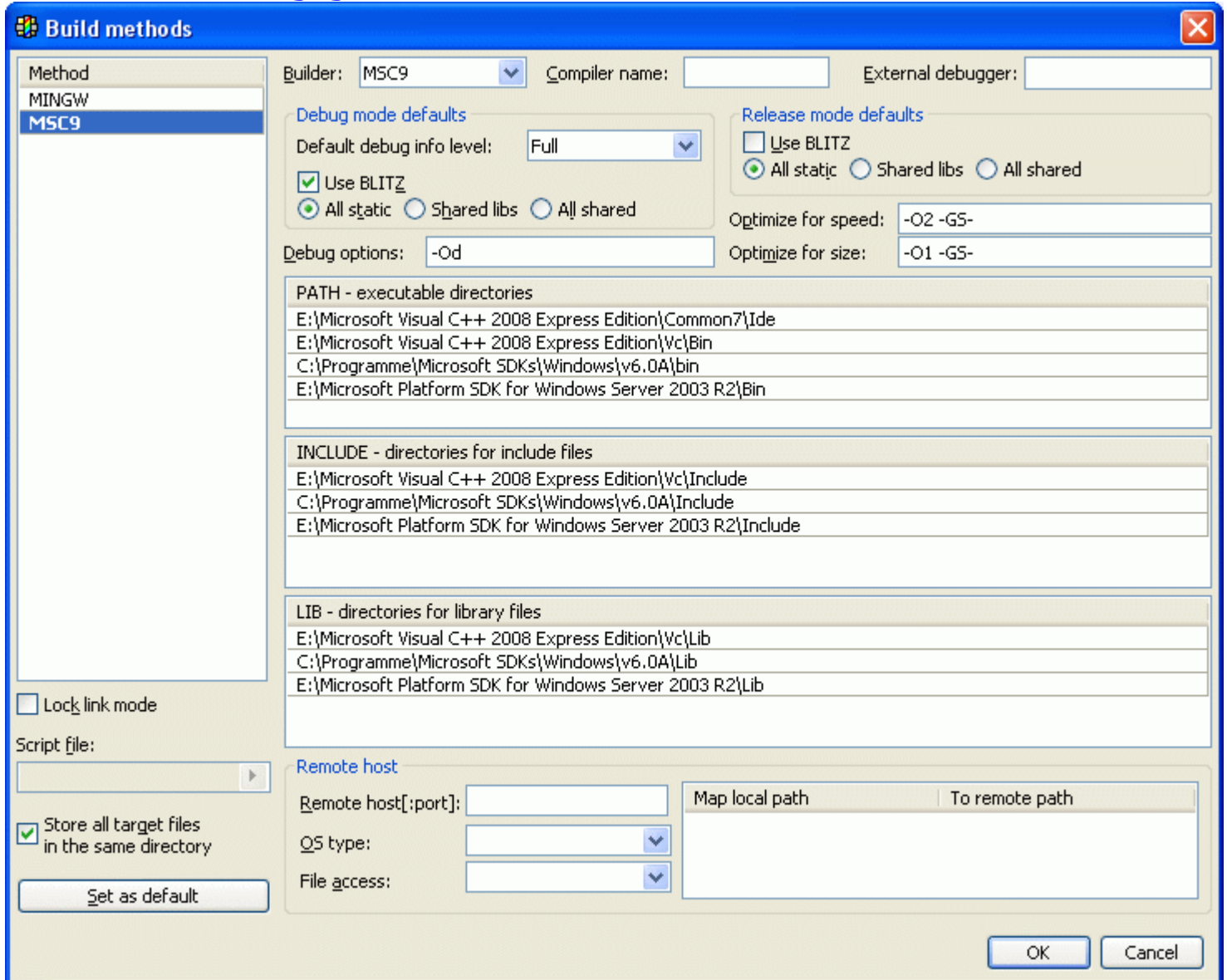
here is a screenshot of my configuration:
