Like has now case sensitive parameter (default: false). In fact it works only with postgres which on default is case sensitive (opposite to mysql or mssql) and if a value of this parameter is false postgres uses ilike command. Example:

```
SQL * Select(ID, NAME)
    .From(PERSONS)
    .Where(Like(NAME, "%JA%", true))
```

output:

```
select id, name from persons where name like '%JA%'
```

```
SQL * Select(ID, NAME)
    .From(PERSONS)
    .Where(Like(NAME, "%JA%"))
```

output:

```
select id, name from persons where name ilike '%JA%'
```
