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Hello all

I have compiled and run successfully AllFor18n in Linux and after exporting the .tr file, this appears empty only with:

LANGUAGE "ES-ES UTF-8";

and I get in the lower side a window with:

when I double click over the lines it sends me to the messages in Taiwanese. For example, in CtrlLib.t:

T_("(default)")

deDE("(Voreinstellung)")

esES("(por defecto)")

fiFI("(oletus)")

frFR("")

itIT("(predefinito)")

roRO("(implicit)")

ruRU("")

srSP("")

the "/home/upp/uppsrc/CtrlLib/CtrlLib.t(20): invalid language" error moves the cursor over the line

It is the same in the rest of .t files.

Do you know what to do?
