Not even to mention the case where app for touchpad console computers with no keyboard is being developed

It does. You just need two clicks (and not doubleclick).

I believe this is the same way as is used elsewhere (e.g. we have been completely inspired by Visual Studio behaviour back then .

Single click is problematic - you would not be able to move cursor without editing.
