A way to do it is downloading a build from <http://www.ultimatepp.org/svnbuils/>

To update it you can download the latest svn source with this command line Quote:svn checkout <http://upp-mirror.googlecode.com/svn/trunk/> upp-mirror-read-only (svn required). Copy this source in upp-mirror-read-only to upp folder (I think this can be done easier doing menu Project/Svn/Synchronize everything).

Run installed ide, choose uppsrc/ide package and build it. That's it.

Here there is a screenshot.

A funny thing is that you can debug Thelde itself.
