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Hi,

When directly scrolling the selection on the DropDownList's fixed part using the mouse wheel (or with keyboard arrow keys), the current selection position jumps to wrong item when it crosses a separator which is not the first one in the list. It also allows selection of the separator, which it should not.

```
DropDownList droplist;
// ...
for(int i=0;i<10;i++){
    droplist.Add(i,Format("%d",i));
    if(((i+1)%3)==0) droplist.AddSeparator();
}
```

To see the problem, try to scroll from 0 to 9 and back.
