Well, full theming is still under development (well, actually, in planning phase, but chances are that it happens really soon).

Right now, there are two fixed themes - XP-like and Win2k-like. In linux, XP theme is activated by default, as it (surprisingly) fits better with modern Linux desktop themes.

You can affect activated theme by calling `Ctrl::SetXPStyle(bool)` (note that this is temporary solution).
