Perhaps by doing so, the current problem would disappear anyway... I guess the problem there is to do this in X11, however I have checked and at least openoffice is capable of doing just that. The only question is whether it is using regular windows or solves the problem by emulating them...

Then I have spotted several minor problems in Docking that should be fixed.
