While using GridCtrl, I came across a small issue.

When the GridCtrl is empty, and focus is on GridCtrl, there is no indication that the focus is currently on GridCtrl. Unlike EditCtrl, where focus is indicated in form of blue gradient.

How can I make GridCtrl to indicate the focus.

I am using U++ release 3211 on Debian 6 (Squeeze) x86_64 with gcc version 4.4.5 (Debian 4.4.5-8).
