The first lines of source code were added to Ultimate++ in 2008. This is a relatively long time for an open source project to stay active, and can be a very good sign.

Quote:Large, active development team

Over the past twelve months, 10 developers contributed new code to Ultimate++.

This is a relatively large team, putting this project among the top 10% of all project teams on Ohloh.

Quote: Stable year-over-year development activity

Over the last twelve months, Ultimate++ has not seen any change in activity. This is probably a good sign as development is continuing at the same pace and not dropping off.

I think this all gives a very good PR image of U++, which is unbiased (since it is automatically generated) and for free U++is even listed as similar project to Qt4 and Qt5, so it might drive some new users to it, which is always good.
